Double Peony Table Topper

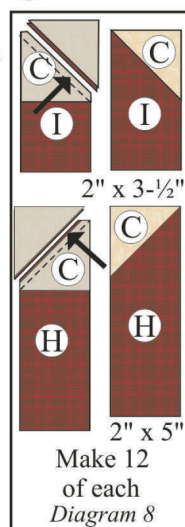
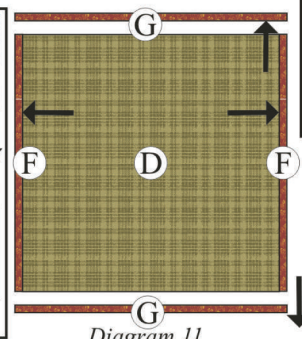
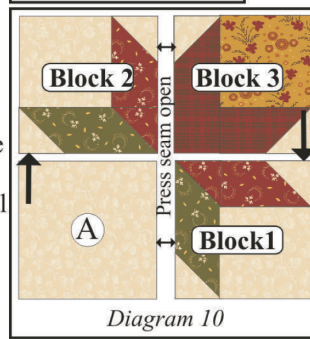
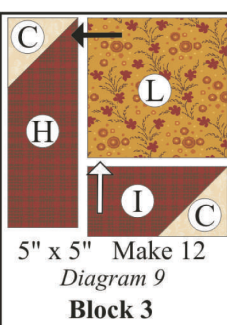

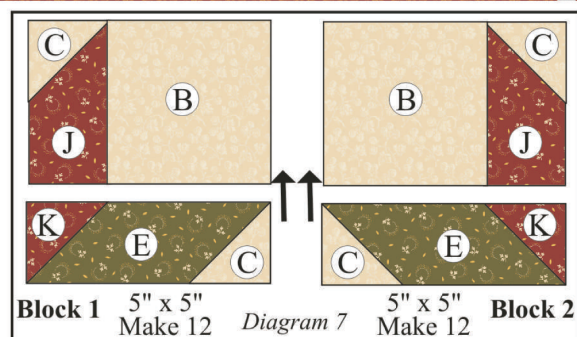
	2022 Acorn & Leaves, cream A Twelve 5" squares B Twenty-four 3-1/2" squares C Seventy-two 2" squares, marked once on the diagonal	Fabric 1	1 yd.
	2018 Plaid, green D One 17-1/2" square	Fabric 2	3/4 yd.
	2010 Falling Leaves, dk. green E Twenty-four 2" x 5" rectangles	Fabric 3	1/2 yd.
	2021 Acorn & Leaves, red F Two 1" x 17-1/2" strips G Two 1" x 18-1/2" strips Binding: 2" x 152"	Fabric 4	1/2 yd.
	2019 Plaid, dk. red H Twelve 2" x 5" rectangles I Twelve 2" x 3-1/2" rectangles	Fabric 5	FQ
	2009 Falling Leaves, red J Twenty-four 2" x 3-1/2" rectangles K Twenty-four 2" squares, marked once on the diagonal	Fabric 6	FQ
	2016 Circles & Fronds, golden L Twelve 3-1/2" squares Backing: One 42" square (allows for 3" extra on each side)	Fabric 7	1-1/2 yds.



1- Sew C's and K's on the marked diagonal line to opposite ends of **twelve E's** in the direction shown in diagram 1. Then sew twelve more C's and K's on the marked diagonal line to the remaining E's in the direction shown in diagram 2 for a total of twenty-four. Trim, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Press open.



2- Sew C's on the marked diagonal line to one end of **twelve J's** in the direction shown in diagram 3. Then sew C's on the marked diagonal line to the remaining J's in the opposite direction as shown in diagram 4. Trim, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance.

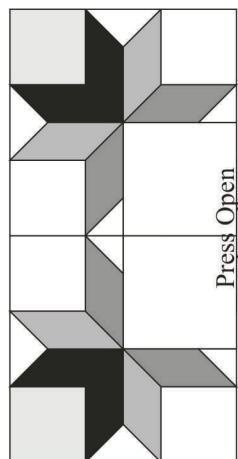


4- Sew twelve C/J units to right side of twelve B's and sew twelve C/J units to the left side of remaining twelve B's as shown in diagrams 5 & 6.

5- Sew the K/E/C units created in step 1 to the bottom of **Blocks 1** and **Blocks 2** as shown in diagram 7.

6- Sew C's on the marked diagonal line to one end of I's and one end of H's in the direction shown in diagram 8.

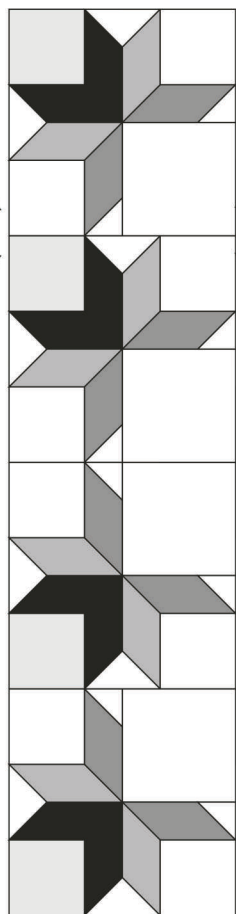
7- Sew a C/I unit to the bottom of each L, then sew the C/H unit to the side as shown in diagram 9. Make 12.

8- Sew **Block 2** to **A**.
Sew **Block 3** to **Block 1**. Then sew those two block sets together. Make 12 blocks. (diagram 10)

9- Sew **F**'s to each side of **D**. (diagram 11)

10- Sew **G**'s to the top and bottom of **D**. (diagram 11)

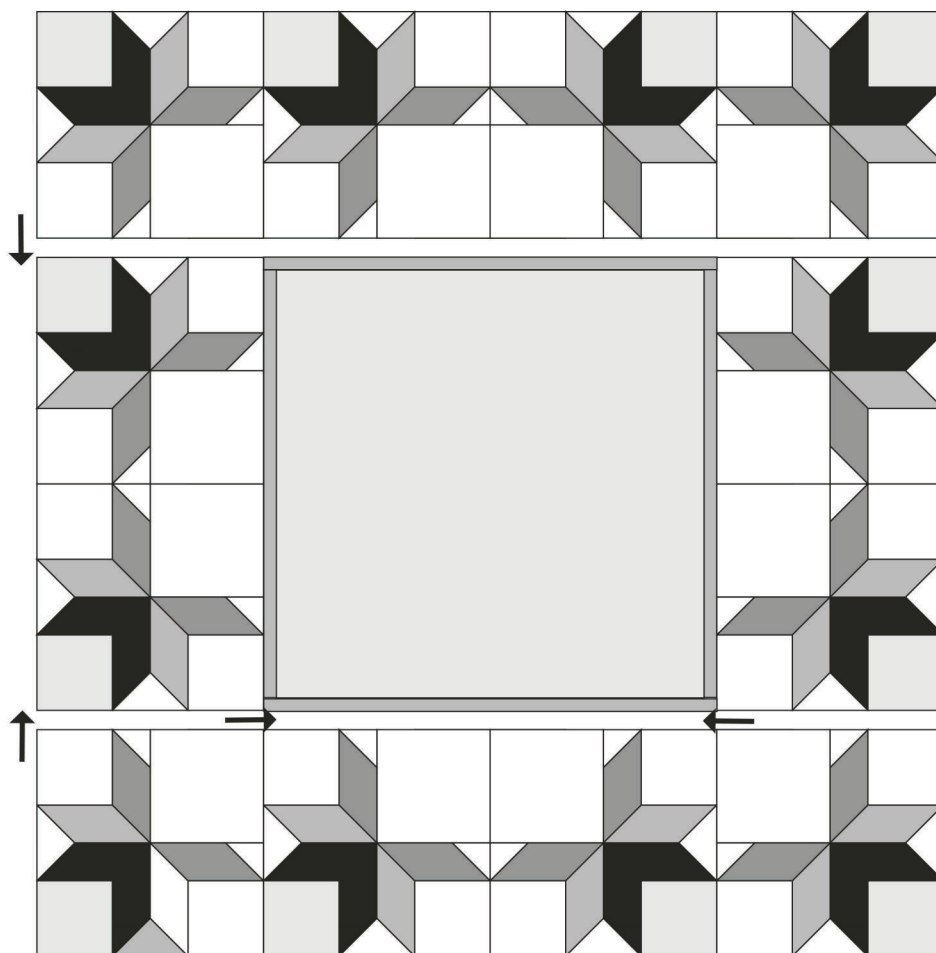

11- Sew two sets of 2 blocks together as shown in diagram 12 for the side borders.

12- Sew the side border blocks to the center block as shown in diagram 14.

13- Sew two sets of 4 blocks together as shown in diagram 13 for the top and bottom borders.

14- Sew the top and bottom border blocks to the center block as shown in diagram 14.

15- Layer backing, batting, and quilt top wrong sides together and quilt as desired.

16- Sew binding on using a 1/4" seam allowance.
