## Cutting:

Techniques:

| Fabric | Measurements |
| :--- | :--- |
| Color 2 | 4 @ $23 / 8 \times 23 / 8$ |
| Color 6 | 2 @ $3 \times 3$ |
| Color 8 | 4 @ $2 \times 2$ |
| Color 10 | $2 @ 3 \times 3$ |

Pieced Corner

## Block Breakdown:

The most obvious way to make this block is by making a HST pinwheel in the center and then some pieced corners added in the Square in a Square fashion. However you could also cut all pieces individually and sew your block into quadrants. I find this a bit more time consuming and give me more chance to make a mistake. So I will go with the pinwheel approach.

## Sewing:

Let's begin by making the pinwheels. Use Color 6 and Color 10 to make four HST, Press towards Color 10 or your darkest color. Sew into a pinwheel. Spin center seam. Trim to $43 / 4$ "


Pieced Corners. Begin by cutting the Color 2 squares in half diagonally. Use Color 8 square as the corner stone and sew two Color 2 triangles to make the unit.

Use the Square in a Square technique to add the pieced corners to your pinwheel.

Press toward the center pinwheel.
