### Block 4

#### Cutting:

<i>Fabric</i>	<i>Measurements</i>
Color 2	4 @ 2 x 2 1 @ 4 ¾ x 4 ¾
Color 5	4 @ 2 x 3 ½
Color 7	4 @ 2 x 2
Color 8	1 @ 4 ¾ x 4 ¾

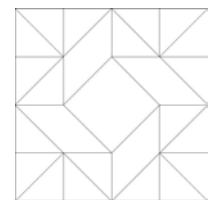
#### Techniques:

Parallelogram

Magic 8

#### Block Breakdown:

There is a lot going on with this block. You can sew this in a couple of different ways. Working in rows you will have to use a partial seam. We are going to make this one in quadrants. This will result in seams in the center block. So if you don't want that, you can make a square in a square and HST, but you are back to the partial seams. We will be using that technique on Block 42, so you can do that one first if you want too.



#### Sewing:

Begin by making the parallelograms. Use Color 5 as your base and add Color 2 and Color 7 as the triangles. Press away from Color 5.



Use Color 2 and Color 8 - 4 ¾ x 4 ¾ squares to make the Magic 8 HST. Press towards Color 2. Trim to 2".



Sew two HST together to form a rectangle.

Time to make the quadrants. Getting the seams to match is a bit tricky so use your glue pen and line them up carefully. Press away from the parallelogram. Make 4

Sew your quadrants together and spin the center seam.
