### Block 28

#### Cutting:

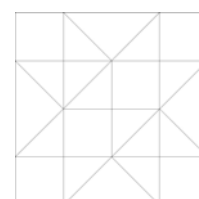
<i>Fabric</i>	<i>Measurements</i>
Color 1	5 @ 2 3/8 x 2 3/8
Color 5	6 @ 2 x 2
Color 8	1 @ 2 3/8 x 2 3/8 1 @ 4 1/4 x 4 1/4

#### Techniques:

HST  
GEESE

#### Block Breakdown:

This block is a variation on the Ohio Star. They always include 4 flying geese and a variety of centers and cornerstones. In this version we are going to have solid cornerstones and only 2 HST as part of the center unit. Not much decision making here needed. Decide how you like to make your geese units and get going!



#### Sewing:

I always begin with the geese when making Ohio Stars. As you know, I enjoy the Four at a Time Method, but use your favorite. Make four identical geese with Color 8 has the goose and color 1 as the sky piece.



Next, make the HST for the center. Use Color 1 and Color 8 squares. Press towards color 1. Trim to 2"



Use these HST and two of the color 5 squares to make the center unit. Spin the center seam.

Sew into rows to web the block together. Press top and bottom rows towards color 5. Press the center row towards the center unit.
