Cutting:

<i>Fabric</i>	<i>Measurements</i>
Color 2	6 @ 2 ³ / ₈ x 2 ³ / ₈
Color 7	1 @ 2 ⁵ / ₈ x 2 ⁵ / ₈ 4 @ 2 x 2
Color 12	1 @ 4 ¹ / ₄ x 4 ¹ / ₄

Techniques:

Square in a Square
Flying Geese

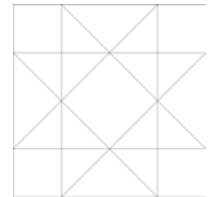
Block Breakdown:

The last Ohio Star, I promise! Once again, we are going to need a Square in a Square for the center. Nothing else to make except the four flying geese.

Sewing:

As you know, I make my geese units first. This week is uses the same Color 2 as the sky pieces but Color 12 for the geese. Have fun!

Then the Square in a Square for the center. Use Color 7 for the center and cut 2 of Color 2 squares 2 ³/₈ x 2 ³/₈ in half diagonally for the triangles. Press towards color 2. Trim to 3 ¹/₂”



Sew into rows to web the block together.

When pressing, the “path of least resistance” will be towards the Color 7 corner blocks.
