### Block 67



#### Cutting:

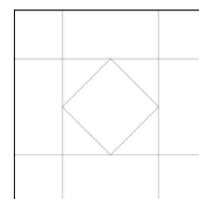
<i>Fabric</i>	<i>Measurements</i>
Color 2	2 @ 2 <sup>3</sup> / <sub>8</sub> x 2 <sup>3</sup> / <sub>8</sub> cut diagonally
Color 6	4 @ 2 x 3 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub>
Color 7	1 @ 2 <sup>5</sup> / <sub>8</sub> x 2 <sup>5</sup> / <sub>8</sub>
Color 8	4 @ 2 x 2

#### Techniques:

Square in a Square

#### Block Breakdown:

I thought you deserved another easy one. This block is built off the center Square in a Square. If you are only making one of these blocks the outside roads are easily made by cutting the pieces as listed. However, if you are making a number of these blocks, I would definitely use the Strip quilting technique to speed it up. I would cut a 3 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> x WOF strip of Color 6 and two 2 x WOF strips of Color 8. Sew them together and then cut into 2" strips.



#### Sewing:

Begin by making the center Square in a Square unit. Press towards color 2.

Lay out all your pieces and web your block together. Press towards Color 6 when possible (especially at the points where the Square in a Square meets color 6)

#### Countdown:

Only 4 more blocks to go!!!!
